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ABOUT US

Tattva Foundation is a Lucknow-based innovation-driven ICT4D research and development organization, which works at the intersection of communities, governance, and technology. Tattva envisions an equitable society where everyone has access to affordable and quality healthcare nearest to their home. Tattva is a scale-up expert which has designed, developed, and scaled up multiple pioneering digital health interventions developed using persuasive technologies and human-centred design science research approaches. Tattva's solutions have to date reached about 90000 direct beneficiaries, primarily frontline workers, impacting an 80-million population. Tattva Foundation works in multiple domains under the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), specifically health, nutrition, livelihood, and environment.

The core offerings of the organization are:

- Design, develop, and operationalize integrated, open architecture, and ABDM-compliant Information communication and technology products such as e/mHealth tools, hospital management information system, labour room MIS, Enterprise Resource Planning IS, etc.
- Conduct public health research in the areas of maternal and neonatal child health, immunization, nutrition, health system studies, including supply chain.
- Design and develop data science solutions also using ML/AI for predictive analysis in the area of public health, education, poverty and livelihood and other domains.

- **Empowering Communities through Technology-** We equip marginalized communities with digital skills, access to e-governance, and community-driven ICT tools to support socio-economic development.

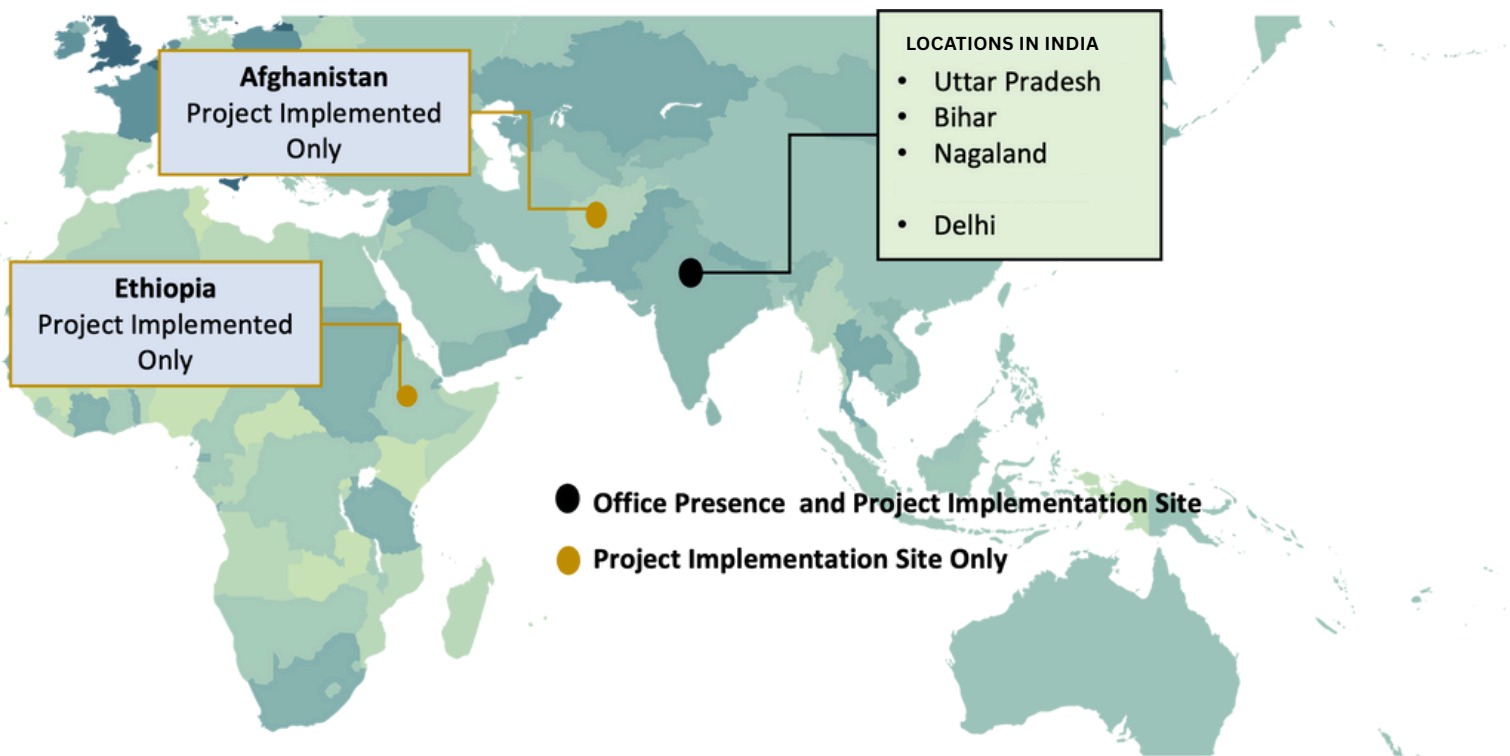

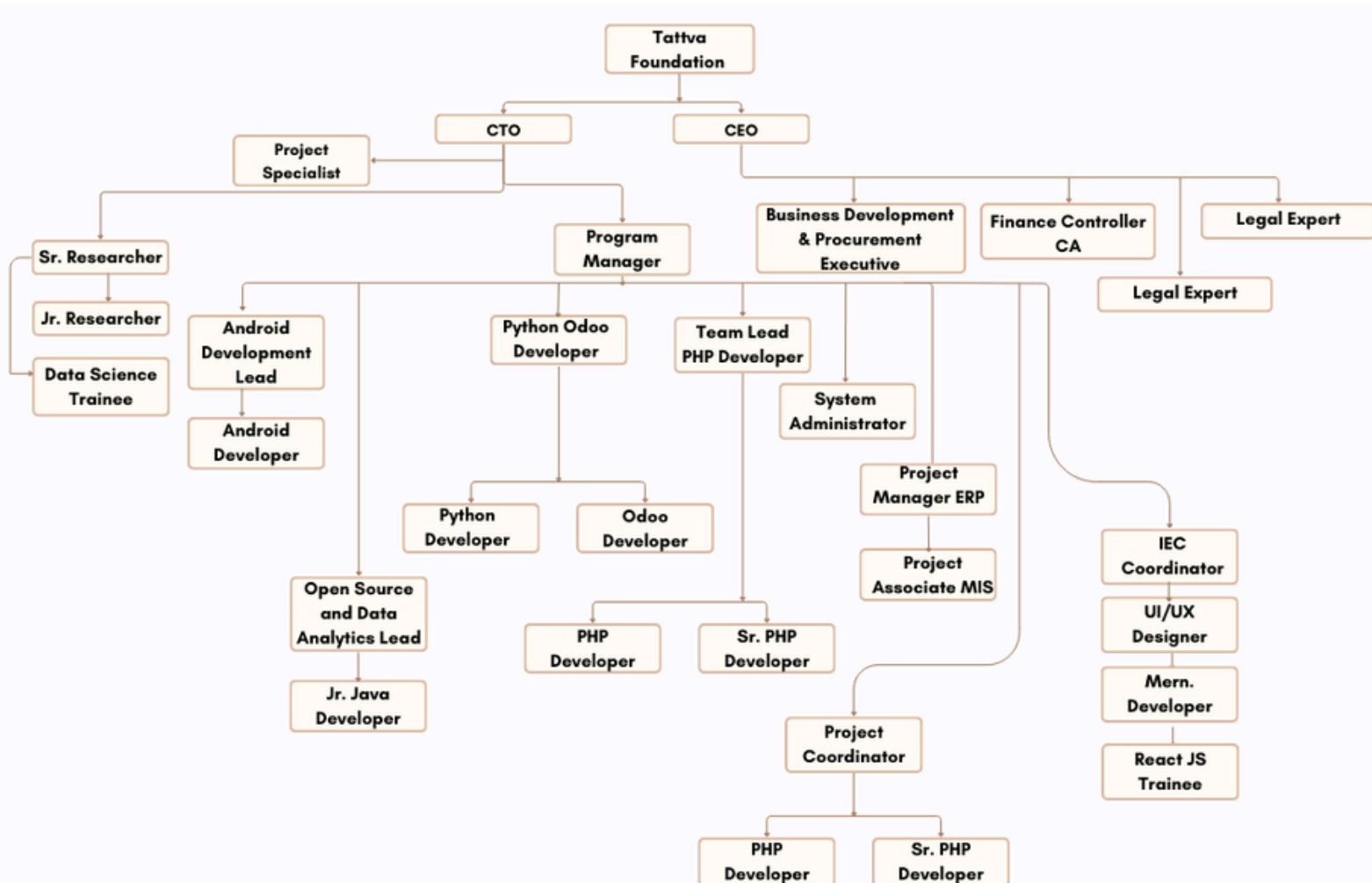

AWARDS



The team successfully developed nCOVID health management tools for the Governments of Nagaland and Afghanistan, with support from the World Bank. Additionally, the team launched Kutukit, an AI-enabled learning application designed to support government school children with content in Hindi. The app has directly reached over 100,000 users, with the user base continuing to grow steadily.

In 2020, the Kutukit Financial Scholarship program was introduced to support students from low-resource families, enabling them to continue their education and pursue their aspirations. These efforts reflect Tattva Foundation's commitment to combining innovation, skill, and empathy to drive social impact. The recognition received from Amar Ujala serves as a valuable acknowledgment of the team's ongoing dedication and youthful energy.
